Two day hiking trips are planned for East Aravaipa Canyon (2 groups of 8 for each hike) utilizing the Klondyke Horsehead Lodge. East Aravaipa requires a special permit that needs to be acquired 13 weeks in advance. I now have the permits for the April 7th & April 9th hikes.

First Group - April 7th hike - First day hike Turkey Creek C approx 5 miles & 200' elevation. April 8th - Hike Aravaipa Canyon to Deadhorse/Hellhole Canyon then up to hellhole approx 10 miles & 100' elevation.

Second Group - April 9th - The second group does a repeat of the first hike, just 2 days later. We will hike Turkey Creek on April 9th and Aravaipa Canyon on April 10th.

We will be reserving the complete Klondyke Horsehead lodge for the trip. The cost of the complete lodge is \$250 per night. The lodge has 5 bedrooms, 3 bathrooms, 2 kitchens, and 2 common lounges (great rooms). See website for additional information. We will be fixing all our own meals at the lodge.
